1. On a motion made by Comm. Perez and seconded by Comm. Trigo that we approve the Regular & Special Commissioners Court Meetings of November 2020 with the correction of the typographical error (bond number) on Nov. 17, 2020 motion item #3.

Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None.”

2. On a motion made by Comm. Perez and seconded by Comm. Trigo that we impose a 90-day Burn Ban. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None.”

3. On a motion made by Comm. Perez and seconded by Comm. Trigo that we approve payment of bills and approve Duval County CRF grant payments to applicable small businesses impacted by the pandemic as recommended by the CRF committee (Small Business Relief - Phase II). Motion carried with all member voting “Aye” Against “None.”

4. On a motion made by Comm. Trigo and seconded by Comm. Perez that we accept Dept. Reports. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None.”

5. On a motion made by Comm. Perez and seconded by Comm. Trigo that we approve to remove all employees from District Attorney county payroll with the exception of Barbara M. Ramirez, remove Omar Escobar from County Payroll, approve a \$25,000

annual salary supplement, to be allocated from the General Budget Assistant District Attorney to Rumaldo Solis, Jr., approve a \$3,560 annual salary supplement allocated from the General Budget - District Attorney, to Gocha Allen Ramirez , 229th District Attorney-Elect and approve the budget amendments to the 229th District Attorney Ch. 59 Forfeiture Budget FY 2020-2021 eff. January 1, 2021. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None.”

6. On a motion made by Comm. Trigo and seconded by Comm. Perez that we approve the Hill Country Budgetary Accounting System User Support for the Cy 2021 (7 users at \$4,460). Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None.”

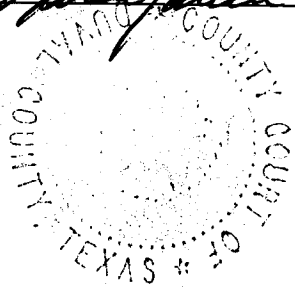
