**1. On a motion made by Comm. Guerra and seconded by Comm. Uribe that we approve the minutes of the Regular and Special Commissioners Court Meetings of June 2021 as presented. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None”.**

**2. On a motion made by Comm.Uribe and seconded by Comm. Guerra that we approve the payment of bills. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None”.**

**3. On a motion made by Comm.Guerra and seconded by Comm. Uribe that we consider action to improve and ratify that Old San Diego to Palito Blanco Road from eastern boundary of FM 1329 running southeasterly to Duval and Jim Wells County, is a private roadway and easement for the benefit of property owners, and further that the roadway is not a public county road and as such Duval County has no obligation to maintain or repair the roadway. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None”.**

**4. On a motion made by Comm. Guerra and seconded by Comm. Uribe that we approve Dept. Reports. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None”.**

**5. On a motion made by Comm. Uribe and seconded by Comm. Guerra that we**

**approve the action regarding the tax refund request of Neel Title Corporation, account number 100657-000-0950 (Owner Salinas SG Lydia) in the amount of \$8,196.61 for the tax year 2020. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None”.**

**6. On a motion made by Comm. Uribe and seconded by Comm. Guerra that we approve to advertise a request for proposals (RFP) to administer the American Rescue Plan funds. Motion carried with all members voting “Aye” Against “None”.**

**7. On a motion made by Comm. Uribe and seconded by Comm. Guerra that we approve to fill the deputy clerk vacancy in the County Clerk office and make adjustments to personnel positions and wages within budget. Motion carried will all members voting “Aye” Against “None”.**
